

ABOUT

Mission of the Dialogue of Cultures - United World Fund is to create platforms and tools for an unhindered dialogue and cooperation between peoples and nations.



Since 2005, the Fund has implemented over 500 projects in spheres of culture, education and environment in Russia and 59 countries of the world.

The Fund works together with the Russian and foreign government agencies, diplomatic establishments, small and medium enterprises, educational institutions and other charities.

In 2015, the Fund obtained consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council



PURPOSES

- assistance in consolidation of peace, friendship and harmony between countries and peoples through the creation and maintenance of platforms and mechanisms for equal and mutually diverse exchange and cooperation between them;
- organization and promotion of educational, scientific, cultural, spiritual, entrepreneurial activities aimed at fostering multifaceted personal development in harmony with society and nature;
- support for the participation of youth in community life by involving them in culturally and socially significant processes and socially useful activities;
- implementation of measures designed to promote environmental and wildlife protection.




V. Publications, popularizing national cultures of peoples and countries of the world
